Addendum #3 Request for Proposal Softball & Baseball Field Improvements: Project 999-421336

Dated October 3, 2025

The Addendum must be acknowledged on your lump sum bid.

NOTE: You must have attended a pre-bid conference in order to be eligible to bid for this project. Receipt of minutes or addenda without being at a pre-bid conference does not qualify your company to bid.

Addendum 3 for the University's **FPM Softball & Baseball Field Improvements** project for **Facilities Planning & Management** is issued to update the RFP Document to remove the sample contract initially included. It also posts a current sample contract for Vendors to review. When competing Section 300, question 19 on page 7 will refer to this replacement contract as opposed to the original agreement.

Questions have been raised after the Pre-Bid meeting held on October 9, 2025. A summary of the questions asked, and the University's responses are as follows:

Question: Regarding the alternate for the Giant Thuja trees, please confirm the minimum size

saplings you'd like us to include in the alternate bid for the six (6) trees?

Answer: Contractor to plant samplings that are 5-6' tall. Location to be field verified with

owner.

Question: Where we tie into the mainline for the softball field, is the removal of the

concrete/replacement of the concrete the responsibility of the contractor? Assuming yes,

but please clarify.

Answer: Yes, any disturbance caused by installation of the storm pipe is the contractor's

responsibility to restore in kind.

Question: With the lay down area being beside the right field bullpen, are we allowed to build another

construction entrance through that bullpen or are we to exclusively to use the left field bullpen? For ease of entry, additional access through the right side would be preferred if

possible.

Answer: Wayne State University or Engineer take no exceptions to building an additional

construction entrance to access from the right field side as long as necessary

erosion and sediment control measures are installed.

Question: Is there a designated area available that isn't a public space, to leave trucks, trailers and

equipment?

Answer: The equivalent of 2 trucks can be left next to the "bullpen" and the 'shot put" area

of the softball field. The same for the baseball field and the batting cage.

Question: The walls in the outfield seem to go from 58" to 68" to 81" without any distance

measurements in between, just general wall width measurements, so I am unsure of how

wide to estimate each area. Left field's far back wall doesn't seem to have a height. I need to know how far in the heigh changes to get you the best possible quote.

Answer: All padding to comply with Site Note 3, "Contractor to provide padding to a height

of 6' or pad entire wall if under 6' tall. Contractor to verify wall heights in field."

Wall heights as noted on plans are field measurements. Contractor to provide consistent height wall padding and mount with variable toe-kick or reveal from

grade.

LF wall is a replica of Fenway Green Monster and is significantly taller than the

required 6' of required padding. Contractor to pad to a height of 6'.

Question What is the preferred width of the boards?

Answer: Board withs are to match existing whenever possible.

Question: Are we doing the backstop as well?

Answer: Assuming this is in regard to baseball padding, yes the backstop should be padded.

Please note existing padding was installed and is to remain centered behind home

plate. This project will pad the rest of the backstop wall as outlined in C-201.

Question: Could please send measurements and wall labels (ex left field 1= 69" tall x 231' wide?

Answer: All padding to comply with Site Note 3, "Contractor to provide padding to a height

of 6' or pad entire wall if under 6' tall. Contractor to verify wall heights in field." Wall heights as noted on plans are field measurements. Contractor to provide consistent

height wall padding and mount with variable toe-kick or reveal from grade.

Question: Does the wall padding require any special printed graphics?

Answer: No graphics are to be provided on the wall padding at this point in time.

Bids are due by electronic submission on no later than 2:00 p.m., October 30, 2025. The link for bid submission will be posted with the bid details at http://go.wayne.edu/bids

Do not contact either FP&M or the Design Firm directly as this may result in disqualification of your proposal.
