Addendum #5 To Request for Proposal For iBio Landscaping Update: Project 211-312745

Dated September 13, 2018

The Addendum must be acknowledged on your lump sum bid.

As a result of mandatory pre-bid ,meeting for the release of our RFP FPM iBio Landscapinig Update, the following questions were submitted. The questions and the University's response is as follows:

1. We will not be able to provide a warranty on any of the transplanted plants (Japanese maple, junipers, and daylilies) due to these are spring dig trees only and WH Canon does not recommend they be transplanted at the requested time.

Response: Due to current outdoor conditions if the plants are placed at the correct depth and filled with nutrient rich soil and is properly watered we feel the transplanted should survive. Please plan accordingly to care for transplanted plants.

- The Turf and Grass specs have a topsoil with a PH between 5.5-7: Soil PH here in Michigan is typically around 7.5 8. It is difficult to lower this PH unless a significant amount of Peat or Sulfur is added to the topsoil. Also, amending with compost and sand will also raise the PH. If a lower PH on the soil mixes is strictly adhered to, there will be additional costs if Peat and Sulfur have to be utilized.
 Response: Keeping to Michigan native soil PH is acceptable.
- We will try to protect existing concrete paving and features, but we cannot guarantee there will be no damage, and we do not have cost for repairs in our base bid.
 Response: Contractor is responsible for repairing items damaged during construction.
- Can we assume that we will be able to remove a panel of the fencing in order to access the patio area? If not how do you propose we get the material into the area?
 Response: The intent was to carry items through the building as was mentioned during the pre-bid. If you feel you can remove and replace a fence panel, we are open to it.
- Please approve the following highlighted plant substitutions that would need to be made in order for landscaping to be complete by Nov 2.
 Response: Substitutions will be reviewed with the successful bidder.
